SAVE YOUR GALLON MILK JUGS!

Plans are already underway for VBS 2017 – Operation Arctic.

Needed are 430 plastic gallon milk jugs to create an igloo.

Thoroughly wash the milk jugs with water and bleach to remove any remaining milk residue which will sour and smell. Bring them to church and put them in Cindy Herring's classroom (Room 9 down the north hall). If you plan to save up jugs at home before

bringing them in, remove the caps and keep them in a baggie, then bring the jugs and baggie with caps when you are ready.
