


How can you be part of this important and life-changing ministry?



Ron & Melin G. Interserve Southeast Asia

Ron and Melin are have been in the U.S. since spring of 2020. They have been working on obtaining visas to return to the mission field. They are currently on Plan C, meaning that when they start the process, the visa restrictions and requirements continue to change and be altered. At the moment, in order to get the long-term visas, they need to enter the country with a short-term visa. Then while in the country, they can apply for the long-term visa. They have begun this process which should allow them to return to the mission field in the next month or so. Please be praying for this process to go smoothly. They long to return to their field and ministry partners there.

One of the ministries that Ron and Melin are heavily involved in is installing clean water systems in communities. The ninth water system was installed in October! The road to the community where they were installing the system was impassible, so the team had to drive through a rice paddy!

The Agricultural Demonstration Farm is enjoying two new calves that have been born. The rainy season has come, but seems to be spotty with the Farm not receiving enough rain. Therefore, many crops need to be hand watered. Peppers are suffering from lack of water. Eggplant has been planted and the kalamansi continue to produce well.
