FOR PARENTS WITH CHILDREN NURSERY AGE-5TH GRADE

Dear Parents,

As you are well aware, fall has arrived and in fact, Thanksgiving is just around the corner! With this in mind, we are so pleased that our fellowship time is resuming, in the gym rather than the Lobby, between the worship service and Sunday School. We look forward to this informal time of connecting with our brothers and sisters in Christ and the sense of “normalcy” that it brings.

With this change, however, comes some concerns regarding our Children’s Church and Sunday School class format. The worship service is typically concluding around 10:30; thus, we would like to have our Sunday School classes begin at 10:50 with a reminder bell at 10:45 to “make your way to class, please.”

With this in mind, we are asking parents of children nursery age through 5th grade to gather your children after the service, whether they are with you in worship, in Children’s Church, or in the Nursery, and have them join you for fellowship time. When the first bell prompts us that Sunday School is about to begin, please see your child/children to their class. This allows Children’s Church leaders and Sunday School teachers time to participate in fellowship and children are not alone in the classrooms for any length of time. Teachers will plan to be in their classrooms by 10:45 to welcome the children and begin their classes at 10:50.

We plan to ring the bell again at 11:45 notifying teachers that there are 5 minutes until classes end. As parents, please make every effort to gather your children from class as close to 11:50 as possible so that our classes can conclude in a reasonable time frame.

We appreciate each one of you and are so thankful for the opportunity to nurture your children in their relationship with Jesus. We trust that this arrangement will allow us all to enjoy a time of fellowship as well as provide a safe environment for all.





Shad & Sarah Deal serve with Ethnos360 training men and women for mission work around the world. This fall, a new group of students arrived at the Ethnos360 Training Center in Roach, Missouri. 39 students began training to serve the Lord, bringing the Good News of Jesus Christ. The Deals work with 12 of these students, which consist of three couples, two single men, and four single women. Shad and Sarah are involved as personal mentors with two of the couples and Shad is a personal mentor for three single men from another Training Team. Pray for the Deals as they mentor these men and women in preparation for leaving their family, home, and all that is familiar to serve the Lord.


The Deals are actively involved in their local church. Their boys, Braden (in 9th Grade) and Brice (in 6th Grade) are building relationships at church with other teens. Shad and Sarah volunteer every Wednesday to cook and serve a meal to teens. Not only are they getting connecting with the youth, but have also gotten to know several couples who work with the youth.

Braden had an incident at school where he had a fainting spell or blacked out. He had an EEG done to rule out seizure activity (Shad suffers from seizures). They are still waiting for the test results. Sarah's migraines have returned. Shad's health is good. He had elevated thyroid levels a few months back, but praise the Lord, he has gotten great reports back. Pray for the health of the Deal Family.

A blessing or a curse?

Holocaust survivor and devout Christian Corrie ten Boom recounts how her sister Betsie thanked God for the fleas infesting their packed barracks. When Corrie resisted the idea, Betsie pointed out that 1 Thessalonians 5:18 says to “give thanks in all circumstances.”



Still, Corrie wasn't convinced — until the sisters realized the infestation kept the guards away, giving prisoners in those quarters freedom to worship and pray. The biting pests, which seemed like added misery, became a blessing.

Anger and bitterness sometimes cloud our vision, causing us to forget to thank God *in* all situations, though not necessarily *for* them. Other times we don't wait long enough for blessings to be revealed. But faith is like waiting through a storm, knowing a rainbow is coming eventually. Meanwhile, the Lord holds an umbrella for us, and the closer with him we walk, the less wet we'll get.
