The church's digital sign at the corner is going to need to be upgraded in the coming year. The framework for the sign will remain the same, but the digital sign is old (12-13 years old) and parts are becoming difficult to find.

The current sign has 24 panels. 18 of the 24 panels have been replaced. These panels are no longer being manufactured so when the supply of these panels is exhausted, the sign will need to be replaced. The estimated cost for a new digital sign is \$16,000. To-date, \$4,100 has been given.

Gary has been busy continuing with the work in the ag shop. Building relationships takes time and it takes effort and God has been helping. Jaime is a man who is a day laborer, not a full-time employee, but he works in the shop area nearly every day and there is a great working relationship between him and Gary. Jaime struggles with many issues and Gary will soon be sitting with Jaime, friend to friend, to share Jesus. Please pray for Jaime's heart to be open and for Gary to have clarity. Heart to heart talks are not always easy, but they are necessary. It is exciting to see God moving.

We recently helped our dear friends and neighbors, Jimmy and Jassmin, move from the El Sembrador grounds to Catacamas. Jimmy will continue to work at the farm ag shop and we are glad for this. Jassmin hopes to start a small business from her home. While it is sad to say goodbye, we are glad they are taking steps to better their family. We had the opportunity to hear Jimmy preach and he did a great job. Please pray for this precious family as they continue to seek Jesus.

Laura has been working in two villages; each has one room for first through sixth grade and a room for Kindergarten. She has been at each school two days a week helping to tutor in Spanish reading and also teaching English as a foreign language. Teaching children is a great way to meet the moms and opens communication. God has given opportunity for Laura to speak into the lives of the children and the moms. Moms in Honduras have the same struggles that moms in the U.S. have. Sharing Jesus, sharing burdens and sharing love are integral parts of the ministry.

Laura has also branched out and is now teaching the first through sixth grade "Sunday School" class that is held on Wednesday evenings during the on-campus family worship service.

Personally, we have been well and we praise the Lord for this. Family time and sabbath remain high priorities. The Wednesday evening campus worship for workers and their families has become our church family and we are glad for this.
