

David Eschenbach Peru


David Eschenbach is preaching and teaching in Peru. In his most recent newsletter, he shares ten prayer requests. Please keep David in prayer as he faces many challenges in his ministry and personal life.

- 1: Pray for God to provide the finances he needs to meet his daily needs and his ministry needs
- 2: Pray for David's godson, Neyder, who has abandoned his youth ministry, wife and children. He feels he cannot repent and be restored. Pray for Neyder to turn back to the Lord and experience God's healing grace and forgiveness.
- 3: Pray for David's health. He struggles with many health issues.
- 4: Pray for baby Pia, who has lung and kidney problems.
- 5: Pray that David can continue losing weight. He has lost nearly 100 pounds but has plateaued since mid-March.
- 6: Pray for those listening to David's Spanish preaching program to be touched by the Holy Spirit.
- 7: Pray for anointing and clarity and improved Spanish speaking skills for David.
- 8: Pray for David to live a more disciplined life.
- 9: Pray for David to have an increased daily devotional life and for a continual Bible study habit.
- 10:Pray for more monthly donors to support David's ministry.

David ends his newsletter with these words:

"May God richly bless you as you sacrifice time throughout your days and weeks ahead praying and interceding for us. Thank you for the blessing you are to us here in Peru. Know that we are also praying for you."
