will be receiving a Bible or a one-year devotional book.







Don Moon World Gospel Mission

Don Moon serves as the Regional Director with World Gospel Mission. He oversees missionaries in Japan, the Middle East, North Africa, and Spain. In his most recent ministry letter, Don says, "I have great people who work with me that make it possible to support the workers in these areas. I continue to connect with ministry partners in South America and India for training and consulting."

Don had been looking into water filtration systems for areas in his region that do not have access to clean water. Don received a great response about water filtration systems, but has discovered that they are a bit out of his league. He continues to research the options and is in contact with partners in the Middle East with hopes of being of help.

On a personal note, Don's son-in-law, Jeremias, took the oath to become a citizen of the United States. Jeremias is originally from Argentina and has made a huge effort to learn English and to adapt to the U.S. culture. Jeremias has a degree in Industrial Management from a university in Argentina and has experience with major companies there, including Coca Cola! He now works as an analyst for a company in the U.S. that services oil and gas pipelines.

This past month Don officiated at the wedding of the daughter of longtime friends in Pennsylvania. He is getting better acquainted with his neighbors in the U.S. He is staying busy and continues to work on new routines and schedules following the death of his wife, Glenda, in April. One new aspect of this new season of life is learning to cook for himself.



SIGN UPGRADE NEEDED

The church's digital sign at the corner needs to be upgraded in the coming months. The framework for the sign will remain the same, but the digital sign is old (12-13 years old) and parts are no longer available.

The current sign has 24 panels. 18 of the 24 panels have been replaced. These panels are no longer being manufactured. More and more panels continue to go out as the weeks go by. It is easy to see the panels that are no longer working.

The estimated cost for a new digital sign is \$16,000. To-date, **\$4,510 has been given.**
