
### All women are invited to the September gathering of CIRCLE OF JOY WOMEN'S FELLOWSHIP Monday, September 19th at 7:00 p.m.

pregnancy resource center

The Pregnancy Resource Center in Grand Rapids offers a number of services and ministries to those in unplanned or crisis pregnancies. They also offer an educational program at many of the area public schools called "Willing to Wait", now known as "W2W Healthy You."

The Pregnancy Resource Center has trained staff that lead the "W2W Healthy You" courses. Marge is one of the instructors. Recently she taught the curriculum at the Juvenile Detention Center. Marge was feeling a bit anxious about her presentation to these students. She prayed for the Lord to give her a heart for these students and to the Lord's love to them.

Soon after the class began, students began opening up. They participated in activities, laughed, and seemed to let some light into their place of despair.

One of the students entered the class with a confident swagger and a hard demeanor that kept the other students at a distance. By the end of the week, this student had softened. In her feedback on the course, she wrote, "In W2W, I learned that love isn't about sex."

More than 6,500 students receive sexual and relational health instruction annually through the eight-session "W2W Healthy You." This program is made available free of charge to more than 65 schools and churches throughout the Greater Grand Rapids community

During this back-to-school season, pray over the leaders of this educational ministry and for the students who go through the sessions to be open to the Lord to speak to their heart.



## SIGN UPGRADE NEEDED

The church's digital sign at the corner needs to be upgraded in the coming months. The framework for the sign will remain the same, but the digital sign is old (12-13 years old) and parts are no longer available.

The current sign has 24 panels. 18 of the 24 panels have been replaced. These panels are no longer being manufactured. More and more panels continue to go out as the weeks go by. It is easy to see the panels that are no longer working.

The estimated cost for a new digital sign is \$16,000. To-date, **\$4,570 has been given.**
