Bibles for the World, based in Colorado Springs, Colorado, works to put the Gospel into the hands of people of all walks of life around the world.

Last year, TransWorld Radio contacted Bibles for the World asking them to partner with TransWorld Radio to reach men with the Gospel; men incarcerated in some of the worst prisons in Kenya, Africa.

The project is called "Every Man a Warrior," which is a special Bible study designed for men in prison, but TransWorld Radio asked Bibles for the World to provide copies of God's Word to go along with the study guides.

Bibles for the World provided more than 2,000 Bibles, both in the Swahili language and English to help fuel this amazing outreach to inmates in the Kericho, Kabarnet, and Eldama prisons.

"Every Man a Warrior" is designed to transform the misery of inmates into spiritual freedom in Christ and the hope of new life that will follow them upon release. "Every Man a Warrior" addresses the root cause of evil by helping men come to God and later disciple others.

Bibles for the World hopes to further the outreach and partner with TransWorld Radio to provide "Every Man a Warrior" to other prisoners in other countries. There is potential to reach inmates in Mongolia.

Will you pray for all of the details to fall into place for the life-changing message of the Gospel to get into the hands of inmates in Mongolia and other prisons around the world?
