

We Care Card Ministry




Receiving a card in the mail is encouraging and can uplift one's spirit.



Celebrating 160 Years of Proclaiming New Life in Jesus Christ 1863-2023







2023 is the 160th Anniversary of Leighton Church. Several people are attending Leighton Church now that were not here 10 years ago for our 150th celebrations which included year-long, weekly oral presentations of church history. Therefore, this year we will be having historical reports printed in the weekly news bulletin to inform (or remind) people of our church's beginnings and events.

WHO WE WERE—WHO WE ARE: A FAITH JOURNEY—Part 47

Leighton UMC's 25th Anniversary of 1996 Facility

On September 12, 2021, Leighton UMC celebrated 25 years in our current structure. On the two Sundays prior to that date, I gave talks about the history of Leighton's churches from the beginning in the 1860's to the current building, the land acquisition, the ground breaking, financing, and vandalism of the 1996 building.

On Sunday, the 12th, during the worship service, I told about the deconsecration and leave-taking of the former (1930) building, the consecration service of the new building, and the mortgage burning service. Several special guests were in attendance on that Sunday: Robert and Sharon Weaver—contractor for the new building; Forrest and Sandee (Finkbeiner) Frank—daughter of Wayne Finkbeiner, building committee chairperson; Brian and Deb Martin—excavator; and Rev. Ray and Joyce Townsend—former pastor. 132 people attended.

During the Sunday School hour, children were in their classes and everyone else was in the sanctuary to hear more information from various committee chairpersons about the building, such as—repairs and improvements in the past 25 years, staff, events, missions, etc. Also, videos were shown of the ground breaking, construction, and mortgage burning.

At noon, everyone enjoyed a catered meal by Nancy and Roger Blain of chicken marsala, cheesy potatoes, green beans, cooked carrots and rolls. Cake and soft ice cream was for dessert. After dinner, those that could, gathered by a new autumn blaze maple tree planted near the flag pole to commemorate this anniversary.
