



Zacchaeus told Jesus, "Half my goods I give to the poor, and if I have defrauded anyone of anything I restore it fourfold." (Jesus liked the way Zacchaeus figured out that things and cheating were part of the reason we owed Jesus so much!) For us to get to heaven He paid the whole cost! Jesus said to him, "Today salvation has come into this house, since he also is a son of Abraham. For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost."
