



Keyless Entry System

Fundraiser Update

THANK YOU..... To all who have contributed towards the keyless entry system fundraiser. A deposit has been paid, the system has been installed and is functional. Installation was done now to avoid a price increase. The total cost of the project is \$10,605. As of June 11th, \$8,468.76 has been given. On top of that, there is \$965 available from undesignated memorial gifts, which when added to the amount donated so far, totals \$9,433.76. We are just \$1,171.24 away from the goal! Your generous contributions towards this project are greatly appreciated. Update on Operation Christmas Child

I was hoping to bring you more exciting news, but unfortunately, I have shingles on my face and by my eye that is causing excessive pain. To all those helping with shoebox projects, there will be a pause in getting more supplies to you until I am able to get more together when I am feeling better.

What can you do until God has restored my health? There are lots of yard sales this time of year. Please look for kids' toys still in the packaging from fast food kids' meals. Ask about t-shirts to use for jump ropes. Look for small tote bags that will fold up small. Sometimes you can find a lot of new things at garage sales and when you tell them about a shoebox and how it is used to tell kids about Jesus, they will give you items for free!

Not sure what can and what cannot go into a shoebox? Stop by the display table in the Lobby for a list of items suggested by Samaritan's Purse. You can also find this list online at https://www.samaritanspurse.org/operation-christmas-child/what-goes-in-my-shoebox-suggestions/

Other sources are Dollar Tree or Amazon. I have a gift list on Amazon.com Just search for my name (Patty Hoekstra) under Amazon lists. The list title is OCC Shoeboxes.

Items needed are: toothbrushes (not pre-pasted), boxes of 24 crayons, single subject notebooks, kids' silverware (IKEA has 6 packs for a good price), 6" rulers, kids scissors, and zippered pencil pouches. School sales will start soon so keep an eye out for these items!

Any questions, please reach out to me. It might take a little longer for me to respond, but I promise I will. Please say a prayer for my husband, Wayne. He is a champ when things happen, but he is lost because he knows I usually deal with pain and this is a whole new level for us to deal with.

Rebecca Getter

United In Christ Ministries (UICM) is a faith based organization serving the kids in the Black Hills and Roosevelt Park communities of Grand Rapids, Michigan. UICM over the years has found many unique opportunities to be the hands and feet of Christ in this community. Their programs are diverse in reaching the youth in the community and equipping them to be leaders right where they are. They believe that the constant presentation of the Word of God serves as the real catalyst for impacting the youth in the community.

This month Rebecca Getter published a special report to highlight summer camp and say a heartfelt thank you to the church family. Your prayers, support, and generosity made a life-changing week possible for dozens of children.

One of Rebecca's favorite moments came from a 4th grader's journal, where they wrote: "This is my favorite camp but we are going to leave tomorrow. I had a lot of fun here. This place was really fun I hope we can come here next summer. When we leave it will be sad because we have to leave early and I want to stay longer. Thank you Jesus. You die for our sins and I'm really really happy because you cared about us. You died on the cross for us. Thank you for keeping us from the devil. He is why we fight."

The child's words are a sweet and powerful reminder that these kids are learning the truth at camp and it's sinking in.

Here are a few highlights:

\$30,000 raised to make camp possible-80% of UICM campers attended completely free!

69 campers experienced a week of love, fun, safety, and deep connection with Jesus.

10 kids were baptized, and 8 gave their lives to Jesus for the first time.

59 staff gave up PTO, comfort, and sleep to pour themselves out in service.

43+ individuals were praying for them from home-thank you!

4 campers went home without knowing where they would sleep that night. But for a week, they were safe, full, and able to just be kids.

UICM feels incredibly honored to go to camp every year and thankful for everyone that invests to make it possible.

Please keep praying for these campers and staff, and for Diallo. He is a young man from UICM who is heading to Belize next month on a mission trip. He's gone from being served to serving others-a beautiful example of lasting fruit.
