You can do just that on Tuesdays from 2:00-3:00 p.m. Pastor Dennis' office is open to anyone who would like to come in and talk. No appointment needed!





APPS: IT'S AN ONGOING CHAT





SKOUT is a location-based dating app and website. While users under 17 are unable to share private photos, kids can easily create an account using a different age.



INSTAGRAM is a photo/video sharing app. Profiles can be public, allowing anyone to see or comment. Teens can create fake accounts to hide content and use the messaging feature.



KIK allows anyone to contact and direct message your child. Kids can bypass traditional text messaging features. KIK gives users unlimited access to anyone, anywhere, anytime.



MEETME is a dating app that allows users to connect with people based on geographic proximity. As the app's name suggests, users are encouraged to meet each other in person.



AMONG US is a space-themed online multiplayer social game where players can message and chat with each other.



BEST SECRET FOLDER is specifically meant to hide photos and videos. It features password protection, decoy videos, and alarm settings.



CALCULATOR% is only one of several secret apps used to hide photos, videos, files, and browser history.







Bill and Lydia Allshouse The America's Region



Bill and Lydia Allshouse were invited to join World Gospel Missions The America's Region in 2020 where they are involved in a more global outreach including Mexico. Their ministry is to share God's love wherever they are, to make disciples, and to collaborate where needs arise throughout the America's through accounting and ministry projects.

The Allshouse's wondered when God would answer their prayers and finally give them the green light in regards to the ongoing construction of a Christian School in Iraquato, Mexico. For months, they have been waiting for the final permit to begin Phase II. They are thrilled to announce on July 7th, they received the last permit! God clearly said, "Now is the time." Praise His holy name!

Thanks to the Lord's provision, progress is being made at the worksite. Due to local regulations, construction by local workers is only allowed when U.S. teams are present-making every mission team visit vital. In July, a youth team from Hope Missionary Church in Indiana served at Bella Vista. The youth ministered through the breakfast club, at various churches by hanging out with the church youth, and at the Wesley Institute construction site. They prepared the ground for the preschool/kindergarten playground by removing old soil, leveling, and compacting new packing soil by hand and with a backhoe.

The new construction area will feature a two-story building to complete the preschool/kindergarten classrooms and three elementary classrooms. There is another building with three pre-K classrooms, a space for the teachers, and bathrooms. With the site now ready and permitted, the Allshouse's are moving into a season of exciting growth and construction.

This season of waiting taught the Allshouse's about trusting God's perfect timing. Maybe if you're in a long, dry stretch of your own-be encouraged! God is never late. God reminds us of His faithfulness through verses like:

Isaiah 60:22 "At the right time, I the Lord, will make it happen."

Psalm 27:14 "Wait patiently for the Lord. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD."

The Allshouse's are asking for prayer for more people to respond to the call and serve in Mexico. Also, pray as they move forward on the two-story classroom buildings for the elementary/middle school, the administration building, and the auditorium/cafeteria.
